Learn the art of cutting pieces free form and how to use unusual fabrics and found objects to create landscapes that live only in your mind. We will talk about how to create a good composition and use design elements that will make your landscape a true paradise. Students will leave with a 12” by 12” original landscape and the ability to create many more.

Michelle graduated from The Fashion Institute of Technology and worked in New York City designing women’s lingerie having appeared on the Sally Jesse Raphael Show and her designs were featured in Vogue, Weight Watchers and Ebony magazines. Level: Some sewing background

Fusible Web

A piece of Muslin 13” by 13”

A piece of batting 14” by 14”

Cutting supplies including a pair of good fabric scissors.

Sewing machine and related supplies and threads.

At least 5 of the following (think outside the box of traditional quilting): Unusual fabrics such as sheers, laces, velvets, silks, gauzes, bridal netting, ribbons beads, buttons, found objects, etc.
