

Silk Painting 101

Students will experience silk painting with minimal drawing required. Layering dyes on silk and using a very simple experimental printing technique will be used. Students will be shown how to transfer a random, accidental design of multicolored dyes to their silk. After a quick dry, students may add decorative lines with Luminaire permanent resist. Voile! If you love color this is for you.

Note: These dyes require steam setting. The instructor will steam the silk at no extra charge. Students may pick up in less than a week at the instructor's studio. If mailing is necessary, there will be no additional charge.

Instructor: Suzanne Visor

Suzanne currently teaches silk painting in her home studio, at Village Wools and the AAAI Balloon Museum in Albuquerque. Her degree is in Art Education from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She has taught art in public, parochial and BIA schools off and on for the last 45 years. She loves teaching adults as well as children. Students' enthusiasm for learning this medium is her greatest reward.

With 16 years of silk painting experience, Suzanne creates and shows silk garments and wall work at the Albuquerque Museum Gallery Store and at Sumner and Dene Gallery downtown. She is a member of Silk Painters International having juried, judged and critiqued professionally at three international conferences.
